

The Veteran's Committee donated Bed-Bug Proof Mattresses Covers, Bed-Bug Proof Pillowcases and a Commercial Carpet Cleaner to the local Nation's Finest Transitional Housing Facility for Homeless Veterans. The Nation's Finest Transitional Housing Program offers a safe place for Veterans to stay while assisting them in locating affordable housing. During this process Veterans receive case management and career development services along with group support and educational activities. On the average Nation's Finest places thirty residents a year into independent housing. Nation's Finest relies primarily on grants and donations such as our proposal and presently do not have the funding available to purchase these items. An Elks National Foundation Grant of \$2500 combined committee funds provided the funding for the purchase.

The Veterans Committee meets monthly on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month at 6 PM at the Lodge.


