I would like to sincerely thank all the current officers and volunteers whose


dedication and hard work help make this lodge function so well. March also brings opportunities to look ahead and get involved.

**Dues Update:** The annual dues should be paid before April 1, 2026. The dues are \$186 per member. Add \$1 if you want a spousal card. About 600 members have prepaid their dues as of March 1, 2026. There will an increase of \$10 in the dues on April 1, 2026. Those of you who are prepaying next year's dues can still pay the lower amount. Those incoming members after April 1, 2026 will be paying \$196. The Application fee will also increase April 1, 2026 from \$50 to \$100.

We will end the fiscal year with 1400 members; however, I anticipate losing about 110 members due to lapsation.

**Special award:** Clay Flenniken, who served as our Exalted Ruler in 1993-1994, will be receiving an award from the Masonic Order on Saturday April 18, 2026 at the Masonic Hall, 517 G Street, Eureka. 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
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## Spring is Coming — & The Roamers Are A-Staying!


As we head toward spring adventures, March reminds us that our RV group is more than a club — it's a community on wheels.

## Elks Boys & Girls Club of the Redwoods Kids Club House Improvement Project

In the 2026 September edition of the Herd Talk it was announced that the lodge had selected the upgrading of the Boys and Girls Club of the Redwoods Kids Club House facility which serves kids kindergarten through sixth grade as the lodge's "major community improvement project for the year."

The Club House Phase I of the project completed in August consisted of a new set of Cubbies, wall damage repair, new shelving in Library and Pantry areas, painting Interior and Shed, installing new Front Door along with a Hot Water Heater and Faucet in kids' restroom.

New window screens were also installed and along with play-ground chips to cover outside dirt area. Phase

II has been completed with the installation of new kitchen cabinets, a new dishwasher along with a new coat of paint.

What started as a simple project turned into more than anticipated with the final cost of the project of more than \$12,000. With donations from local businesses and lodge members along with the \$4000 ENF Beacon Grant Funds the final cost to the lodge was \$246.75.
